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Q. Which Employers Provide CPR Training for Their Employees?

On April 19, 2004, Jim Cantalupo, the CEO and chairman of McDonald's, died after suffering a heart attack while attending a company meeting in Orlando, Florida. Mr. Cantalupo was 60 years old. His death is particularly tragic because he had recently led McDonald's in its initiative to offer more healthful food choices.

Companies that suffer the collective trauma of the death of an employee, particularly an executive, while at the office or on company business, are presented with a unique opportunity to seize the moment and become leaders in CPR training.

CPR saves lives.

Brain damage begins to occur in humans after they are deprived of oxygen for only 4 minutes. Four minutes is not a very long time – most ambulances do not arrive within 4 minutes – but it can seem like an eternity for those who stand helplessly watching a colleague die.

Some companies respond to the loss of an employee by instituting mandatory CPR training for all current employees. Thereafter, on an ongoing basis, CPR training is then simply integrated into the orientation process for new hires.

This is a relatively inexpensive way for a company to maximize the chances that co-workers will be able to save lives on the job. In addition, employees who are trained in CPR will take their live-saving skills with them when they leave their jobs, and they may find themselves saving the life of a family member, friend or stranger.
